Directions:

5. The collage should include the following elements. Each item does not have to be labeled as the intended element because it will be described in the presentation.

 - d. A personal long-term goal (meta/logro)
 - e. Five images that represent your personality
6. You will present this collage to the class to explain where the elements listed above are represented in the collage.
